

Minimum Graduation Requirements

In order to graduate from Insight, students:

1. Complete the Conduct phase according to its criteria, including successful completion of three required, semester-long tutorials:
 - Academic Writing
 - Library Research
 - Quantitative Analysis

2. Achieve college and career-level proficiency on a standardized test such as the PSAT, SAT, Pre ACT, or ACT. (As best we can, Insight will assist students who require testing accommodations to obtain them.)

3. Earn all required credits (credits transferred from other high schools can meet these requirements if approved by a student’s academic advisor).

INSIGHT COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

The minimum requirements for graduation are shown below. Insight expects students to pursue advanced learning in categories that align with their interests and goals, using coursework as a building block for their independent research, entrepreneurial, and/or creative projects.

Category	Units Required	Required Courses/ Topics
Cultural Studies	4	US Media, World Media
Health	3	Health, Lifetime Physical Activity
Mathematics	8	Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, Advanced Math
Natural Sciences	3	Life Science, Physical Science, Lab Science
Social Studies	3	American History, World History
Second Language	4	Four semesters of the same language
